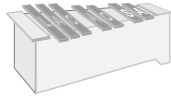

- 405 Freeway North, exit at Artesia Blvd., head towards the beach (west). Follow the directions below*.
 - 405 Freeway South, exit at Inglewood Ave. Turn right on Inglewood. Drive to Artesia Blvd., turn right. Follow the directions below*.
 - 91 Freeway (west). The 91 becomes Artesia Blvd. Follow the directions below*.
- * **Hermosa Valley School:** Drive about 3 miles until you cross Pacific Coast Hwy. Continue on Artesia (Artesia changes to "Gould" at Sepulveda - just keep going) down to a "double" stop sign; first Ardmore, then **Valley Dr.** Turn left on Valley Drive. Drive down the street approximately one mile; the school is on the right. Park in the first or second school lot or on the street.
